The International Menopause Society is pleased to announce the establishment of

### **The IMS/Wyeth Pharmaceuticals Henry Burger Prize**

The Prize, named to mark the great contribution that Professor Henry Burger has made to the field of menopause, will first be awarded during the 12th World Congress on Menopause in Madrid, Spain, May 19–23, 2008. The Prize of US\$ 2000 will be awarded to the investigator who is judged as having published the most significant contribution(s) to the field of menopause in basic science or clinical studies in the 2-year period immediately following the preceding World Congress.

Applications and nominations are invited for the Prize. Individuals may apply themselves or be nominated specifically by another person. Groups may not be nominated. Nominations must be sent to the IMS Executive Director, enclosing copies of the relevant publications, published during the time interval from November 1, 2005 to November 1, 2007. The publications must be in a peer-reviewed journal, in print (not e-pub). Judging of entries will be undertaken by the Scientific Prize Subcommittee specially appointed by the IMS President.

The Closing date for applications/nominations to be received by the Executive Director is **February 19, 2008**.
